AMBER KEMP

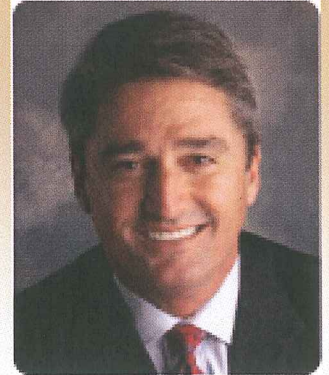
Amber Kemp is a business management major from Terre Haute. After graduation she plans to attend graduate school to obtain a master's degree in student affairs and higher education.

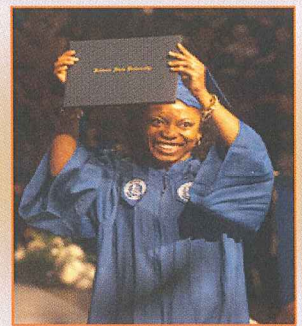
